The Value of Challenge Grants

Challenge Grants:

- Build institutional capacity by providing enhanced space
- Strengthen community support for the organization

Project Eligibility

Eligible projects include:

- Facility construction/renovation
- Real estate purchase
- Major integrated equipment costs of \$300,000
